- Decide on a colour theme.

Don't go for one colour within your theme, choose a couple of colours that are in harmony.

- Try to limit prints and pattern as much as possible.

It might sound fun to let your little ones to wear their favourite Disney character on their shirt or dad to wear that t-shirt with his favourite type of motorbike on it, but this can be quite distracting in your photos. Go for something that will look timeless and classic as your photos will be treasured memories for years to come.

- Don't wear something that is too small or too large on you.
- Don't wear high heels you struggle to walk in. Most of my sessions are outdoors so I don't recommend wearing heels at all, unless your session is an engagement session.
